#### Visa:

### Travelling directly to Jeju – Special entry arrangements for the Jeju Island

All visitors, except nationals of the 11 countries and territories below, can enter Jeju Island without a visa for a stay of up to 30 days, if their purpose is tourism.

However, those visitors who need to obtain a visa to enter the Republic of Korea other than Jeju Island MUST directly enter or leave Korea through the airport or harbour of Jeju Island.

For example, entries to Jeju Island through stopover at Incheon airport don't meet the non-visa entry requirements.

- List of non-eligible countries and territories

  Afghanistan, Macedonia, Cuba, Nigeria, Ghana, Sudan, Iran, Syria, Irag, Palestine,
  Libya
- What's needed for non-visa entry
  - ✓ Return flight ticket
  - ✓ Hotel information (name of the hotel, phone number etc.),
  - ✓ Invitation letter (will be sent to all participants later)

Please note that if your Korean visa applications have been rejected before, your non-visa entry to the Jeju Island might be refused.
